



Call for Abstracts for the 11th Tissue and Motion Research Conference

The Tissue and Motion research network within KI is arranging a yearly conference for researchers at KI working in the fields of stem cells, regenerative medicine, and motion. The 11th version will be taking place on November 9-10th 2022 at Djurönäset (Stockholm Archipelago). We invite all interested researchers to submit their abstracts. Abstract submission deadline is September 15th.

There will be awards for best oral and poster presentation!

Abstract selections are peer reviewed by the scientific committee and acceptance is based on the quality of scientific content. Some abstracts will be selected for a short oral or poster presentation as part of the program at the conference.

Invited speakers do not need to send abstracts unless they wish to submit their own research results (other than what they present as an invited speaker).

Instructions for abstract:

- An abstract should be a maximum of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a full A4 page in length to include title, authors, department, and body text (background, methods, results, conclusions). Figures and/or tables can be included within the text body limit, Use Arial, font size 12.
- Use paragraph breaks between title, author & address, and abstract body.
- Use bold font for the abstract title.
- Write your abstract in a way so that researchers outside your specific research field can understand the findings presented in the abstract.
- Abstract should be submitted as a pdf-file to tissueandmotion@clintec.ki.se. Write "Abstract Tissue and Motion Conference 2022" in the subject line.
- Abstracts will be selected for oral or poster presentation. During registration you can choose what you would prefer. However, we cannot guarantee selection based on this preference.
- **Abstracts deadline is September 15th 2022.** Remember to also register for the conference!
